


2. Installing the VESA Adaptor



Note: Choose the appropriate screws, washers and spacers (if necessary) according to the type of screen. • Screw the VESA adaptor onto the display.



Tighten all screws but do not over tighten.

Maintenance

- Check that the bracket is secure and safe to use at regular intervals(at least every three months).



Component Checklist


IMPORTANT: Ensure that you have received all parts according to the component checklist prior to installing. If any parts are missing or faulty, telephone your local distributor for a replacement.






1. Attaching the VESA Adapters to the Mounted Head plate

The VESA adaptor is only compatible with VESA 200x200 flat mounted head.





Attach the VESA adaptor to the mounted head using the appropriate screws so that the hole pattern can be extended to Max VESA 400x400.

Tighten all screws but do not over tighten.
